

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

VENUE

The workshop will take place at the **Faculty of Modern Languages and Literatures**, in the **Collegium Novum** building which is part of the AMU's Central Poznań campus. The address is: Al. Niepodległości 4, 61-874 Poznań ([click here to go to Google Maps](#)).

Collegium Novum is conveniently located within easy walking distance from Poznań's main railway station, the Imperial Castle (*Zamek Cesarski*), Adam Mickiewicz Square, as well as numerous hotels, restaurants and cafes. A slightly longer walk leads to the Old Market Square (*Stary Rynek*).

AMU Faculty of Modern Languages and Literatures (Polish: *Wydział Neofilologii*) has been in existence for more than 30 years, continuing the tradition of the former Faculty of Philology. The Faculty offers 40 different bachelor's and master's degree courses, and also runs postgraduate and doctoral studies.

TRAVEL

By train: Poznań is located roughly midway between Warsaw (280 km) and Berlin (240 km), making it an important transport hub in Central Europe. The city is well connected by rail to major destinations across Poland as well as to neighbouring countries, with a wide network of frequent services. All trains arriving in Poznań stop at Poznań Main Station (**Poznań Główny**). For tickets, please visit [PKP Intercity](#).

By plane: **Poznań-Ławica International Airport** is situated approximately 7 km from the city centre. Daytime bus lines 159 (to the railway station) and 148 connect the airport directly to the workshop venue and the city centre (night bus line 222 is also available). PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The centre of Poznań is easy to navigate on foot and most key locations in central Poznań are within walking distance of the workshop venue. At the same time, the city offers a well-developed public transport network, ensuring quick and efficient connections to more distant areas via trams and buses. ACCOMMODATION

Many accommodation options, including hotels, hostels, and private apartments, are available within convenient walking distance of the workshop venue, particularly in the nearby districts of Old Town (*Stare Miasto*) and Jeżyce. These areas offer a wide range of choices to suit different budgets and preferences.
